



Last month marked the one-year anniversary of the death of Michael Reinhoehl at the hands of four officers from area agencies and precincts tasked by US Marshals with apprehending him. Reinhoehl had allegedly been recorded on surveillance video killing a member of the Patriot Prayer group during a clash between anti-fascists and right wing militia members in Portland, Oregon

the week before. During the hunt for Reinhoehl, then-President Trump tweeted that officers should "do their job and do it quick." Although eyewitnesses said otherwise, the official account states Reinhoehl fired first and died of return fire from 40 rounds. The officers were cleared of criminal wrongdoing in September 2021 amidst public concern the manhunt was an example of extrajudicial killing.
